What do I need to do?

- Be employed in a salon and preferably have at least three months salon experience.
- Use the time with your In-salon Assessor to maximum benefit.
- Plan assessment appointments and arrange suitable models.
- Complete coursework outside of work time.

How will I achieve my Diploma?

Training and assessments will happen in your workplace and be carried out by an ITS Assessor in conjunction with your Salon. You will sign a Service Agreement that details the cost, the agreement is for a minimum of 12 and maximum of 24 months and you must complete within this time. The average time to achieve the Diploma is 18 - 20 months. You will need to achieve 9 units covering:

- Health and safety
- Salon reception duties
- Customer consultation
- Cutting hair
- Plait and twist hair

- Set and dress hair
- Shampoo and condition hair
- Styling hair
- Change hair colour

What are the costs?

There is an initial payment of £400 followed by monthly standing order payments of £65 payable for as long as you remain in training (see minimum and maximum lengths above)

This covers:

- City and Guilds Registration
- Welcome pack
- E -portfolio
- Access to online City and Guilds assessments (Evolve)
- Access to learning resources

- Training and assessing in conjunction with your salon
- Invigilating tests
- Internal quality assurance
- City and Guilds certificate (on successful completion)
