



The client has fine, medium density, layered hair that is below the shoulders in length.



Following the shampoo, the hair at the top of the head is divided into a 'T' section



The first section of hair is wrapped neatly around a radial brush.



The heat from the hand held dryer is directed in the same direction as the lie of the cuticles to dry the hair.





The first dried section is complete.  
**Note** When the section is dry, the hair must be allowed to cool. This can be done by using the cool heat on the dryer before removing the brush.

The bottom of the hair is dried into soft curls.



Continue drying the hair through the whole head.





The hair is handled gently following drying to maintain the curl until the hair is cooled.



The whole head is now dry.



Using the end of a tail comb, gently separate the curls.



Use the fingers to create movement and texture in the hair.





The finished result.
