



City & Guilds Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing (6008)

For Partner Salons with an Active In Salon Assessor

What do I need to do?

- Be employed in a salon and preferably have completed Level 2 hairdressing qualification
- Use the time with your In-salon Assessor to maximum benefit.
- Plan assessment appointments and arrange suitable models.
- Complete coursework outside of work time.

How will I achieve my Diploma?

All your training and assessments will be carried out by your In Salon Assessor and happen in your workplace. You will sign a Service Agreement that details the cost, the agreement is for a minimum of 12 and maximum of 24 months and you must complete within this time. The average time to achieve the Diploma is 18 - 20 months. You will need to achieve 6 units covering:

- Creatively style and dress hair
- Cut hair using a combination of techniques
- Provide client consultation services
- Colour and lighten hair
- Cut men's hair using basic techniques
- Hair colour correction services

What are the costs?

An initial payment of £500 followed by monthly direct debit payments of £100 for as long as you remain on programme and based on the minimum and maximum times above.
