

Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement

Who is this course for?

Run in partnership with Waverley Training Services in Farnham, this course is for people who are, or will be, assessing learners for vocational qualifications and Functional Skills. Achieving this qualification is an opportunity to stretch your skills, improve your career prospects and put something back into the industry.

The qualification is part of a suite of Training Assessment and Quality Assurance (TAQA) qualifications. They offer those who carry out assessment the opportunity to develop and improve their practice as well as achieving a professional qualification.

What are the entry requirements?

- Level 3 hairdressing qualification OR CPD evidence of working at Level 3 on the shop floor. ITS offers the level 3 hairdressing qualification for non-apprentices.
- English qualification either Level 2 Functional Skill or GCSE grade A-C or 4-9. If you do not have this you will be required to take an online assessment which will incur an additional cost.
- Maths qualification either Level 2 Functional Skill or GCSE grade A-C or 4-9. If you do not have this you will be required to take an online assessment which will incur an additional cost.
- Two learners to assess – Learner 1 will need to complete one whole unit or most of. Learner 2 will only require components of a unit or one outcome. You will need to write a brief profile of learner type for each (ex: Maths/English difficulties, issues at work, etc.) and bring them with you to the first workshop.

Additional support in English and maths is available from the course organiser, Waverley Training Services. There will be an additional charge for this.

What qualification will I achieve?

On successful completion, you will be awarded the Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement. This nationally recognised qualification eases your progression to further qualifications such as the Level 3 Award in Education and Training.

What's involved?

There are THREE workshops to attend (all run on Mondays between 09:30 to 16:00), supported by self-study and attendance at a Partner Salon Network meeting. You will need to set aside time to gather and organise your course evidence. The Waverley Training Services tutor will visit you twice during the course to assess you with your learners and your line manager must be made aware of these visits.

The Partner Salon Network meeting is on Monday, 3rd June 2019 at the University of Surrey, Guildford. Please ensure that you can attend all of these meetings prior to booking.

The Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement has 2 units:

- Unit 301: Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment (3 credits)
- Unit 302: Assess Occupational Competence in the Work Environment (6 credits)

Course fees

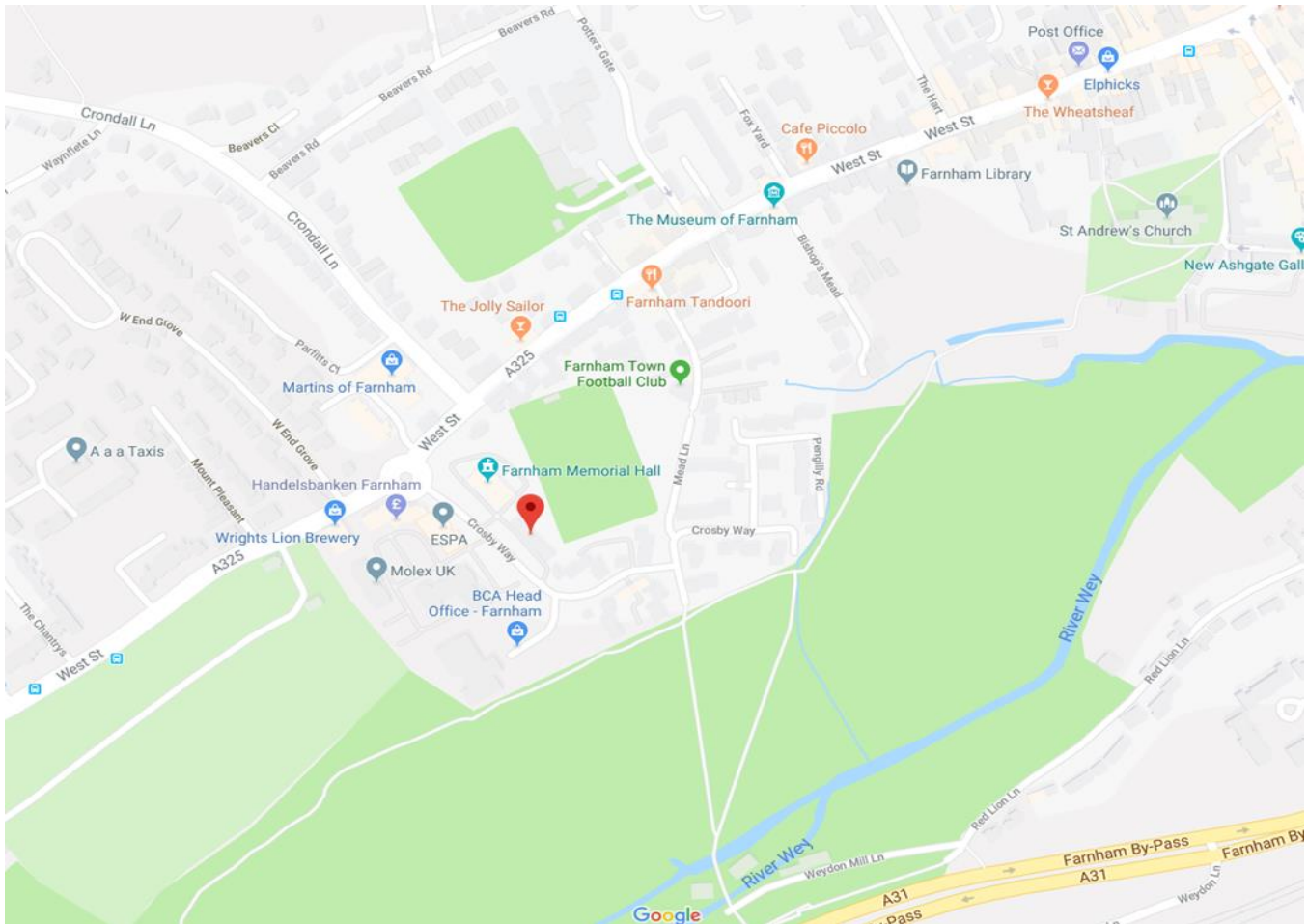

Payment of £100 must be received with your application to reserve your place. The balance must be paid at least 5 working days before the first Workshop.
