

Local Enterprise Partnerships (only in England)

Local enterprise partnerships (LEPs) are partnerships between local authorities and businesses set up in 2011 by the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills (BIS) to help determine local economic priorities and lead economic growth and job creation within the local area. LEPs receive Government funding through a competitive bidding process. Successful bids for a share of the Local Growth Fund focus on generating growth by tackling regional priorities such as business development, roads, facilities, housing and skills needs.
